Saint Lucy Scholarship information 2020-2021 academic year

1. The St. Faustina Conference is offering a non-renewable \$1000.00 scholarship to be awarded to one male and one female, or two scholarships if this does not apply. 2. To be eligible, the student must be a high school student in Spotsylvania County, Virginia. The applicant must have been accepted into a 2-4 year accredited college, community college, university, or technical school. The student must have maintained a 2.5 GPA or higher.
3. The scholarships will be awarded on the basis of financial need, school and community activities, and will be awarded to students of any faith.
4. Submit a personal statement to the committee (see page 2).
5. The "St Lucy Scholarship" committee, along with high school counselors, will evaluate applications.
6. Scholarship awards will be designated for tuition and required school fees only.
7. Application can be mailed to St. Faustina Conference P.O. Box 1574, Spotsylvania, VA 22551 or given to your high school guidance counselor. 8. Applications must be in by March 27, 2021
